The agency screened in and investigated the report of the child's death. Maltreatment was unsubstantiated, and the surviving siblings were determined safe. The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical professionals during the initial assessment. They implemented a protective plan, requiring that the parents' interactions with the surviving children were supervised by relatives early in the assessment. The parents declined the offer of services, and the agency closed the case.

The agency is not in full compliance with the CPS Access and Initial Assessment Standards and did not submit the 90-Day Summary Report in compliance with DSP Memo Series 2010-06. The DSP is working with the agency on the identified issues.
