The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical personnel to complete the assessment. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of physical abuse to the child by the mother's boyfriend. Medical professionals determined the child sustained head injuries and diagnosed the child with Abusive Head Trauma. The infant was deemed unsafe and a Child in Need of Protection or Services petition was filed and the case remained open to provide ongoing case management services in the mother's home. The boyfriend was criminally charged and court ordered to have no contact with the infant.
