The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of physical abuse to the infant by the alleged father. Medical professionals determined the infant sustained injuries consistent with non-accidental head trauma. The infant and his 2-year-old sibling were deemed unsafe, taken into Temporary Physical Custody and placed with a relative. A Child in Need of Protection or Services Petition was filed and the case remained open to provide ongoing case management services.
