The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical personnel to complete the assessment. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of physical abuse to the child by the child's adult cousin. Medical professionals determined the child sustained blunt force trauma to the abdomen, causing her
