The agency collaborated with law enforcement to complete the assessment. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate neglect of the child by the child's mother and the child's father. The Medical Examiner's Office determination is pending. The child's 2-year-old and 4-year-old siblings were deemed unsafe, taken into Temporary Physical Custody, and placed with relatives. The child's 8-year-old half-sibling was deemed safe and remained in his home with his biological mother. Petitions for Protection or Services were filed for the 2-year-old and 4-year-old siblings, and the case remained open to provide ongoing case management services.
