The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical professionals to complete the assessment. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of physical abuse to the child by the father. Medical professionals determined the injuries were non-accidental in nature. The child was deemed unsafe and taken into Temporary Physical Custody. Upon discharge from the hospital, the child was placed with a relative. A Child in Need of Protection or Services Petition was filed, and the case remained open to provide ongoing case management services.
