The agency collaborated with law enforcement to complete the assessment. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of neglect to the 15-year-old child, 11-year-old child, 10-year-old child, and 9-year-old child by the 15-year-old child's father. The children were deemed unsafe and taken into Temporary Physical Custody. The 15-year-old child was placed with relatives. The 11-year-old child, 10-year-old child, and 9-year-old child were placed in a non-relative foster home. Petitions for Protection or Services were filed, and the case remained open to provide ongoing case management services.
