#### Description of the incident, including the suspected cause of death, injury or egregious abuse or neglect:

On December 13, 2023, the agency received a report regarding a 10-year-old child brought to the hospital with a head injury and subsequently pronounced deceased on December 18, 2023. Law enforcement was contacted and initiated a criminal investigation. The Medical Examiner's Office determined the child died as a result of a serious injury. As a result of law enforcement's investigation, an individual was referred for charges. A criminal charge is merely an allegation, and a defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.

#### Findings by agency, including maltreatment determination and material circumstances leading to incident:

The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical professionals to complete the assessment. The Medical Examiner's Office determined the child died as a result of a serious injury. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of physical abuse to the child by an unnamed maltreater. The agency determined the child's siblings unsafe and initiated a Protective Plan. Subsequently, the mother was assessed as protective, and the child's siblings remained with their mother. The family was referred to community services, and the agency closed the case upon completion of the Initial Assessment.

On February 6, 2018, the agency screened-in a CPS Report alleging neglect to the child and all of her siblings by their mother and sexual abuse to the child's now 8-year-old sibling by an unknown maltreater. An assessment was completed by the agency, and the allegations of neglect were unsubstantiated, and the allegation of sexual abuse was unsubstantiated. The case was closed upon completion of the Initial Assessment.

The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical professionals to complete the assessment. The Medical Examiner's Office determined the child died as a result of a serious injury. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of physical abuse to the child by an unnamed maltreater. The agency determined the child's siblings unsafe and initiated a Protective Plan. Subsequently, the mother was assessed as protective, and the child's siblings remained with their mother. The family was referred to community services, and the agency closed the case upon completion of the Initial Assessment.
