The copies of the audit reports may be reprinted back to back; however, we would like the "original" to be the actual original documents. If the department is already in possession of your 2007 and 2008 original audit reports, for the purposes of the RFS, you may submit re-printed back to back copies.

**C.1. Section 2.A.8.3 Scenarios on Social Security Issues, Scenario A
Please clarify the fourth sentence: "She has been trying to work through the pain, but it has become very difficult in part because ..."**

Does this mean that she is simply trying to deal with ("work through") her pain, but is no longer actually employed - or that she is still employed, but finding it difficult to work every day due to her pain? It means that she is no longer employed and is trying to live with the pain.

C.2. For the WEA, is Only one Agency going to be selected for the full allocated funding per Region or multiple independent agencies can be selected and the region's allocated funds shared among them to run as separate entities. For instance if an agency wants only caseloads for \$5 million and don't want to budget for all the \$21.4 million for Milwaukee Northwest and wants the rest given to other agencies, will that be allowed or lower the selection scores?

We will not allocate funding to more than one agency per W-2 region for the purpose of operating a WEA. Agencies selected to administer the W-2 may subcontract to smaller service providers to provide services to a portion of the region.
